## THE BUILDING PERMIT PROCESS

The Building Permit process begins with the Building Permit Application, which covers all types of construction including new construction, additions, decks, remodeling and renovations. Permit Fees will be calculated and upon payment of these fees, along with completed applications and required plans, the application will be ready to be reviewed by the Planning & Inspections staff. Upon approval of the Building Permit application and plans, a Building Permit will be issued by the Building Code Officials and work may begin on the project. The Building Permit must be posted on site for all inspections.

## Submittal of an application does not mean the Permit has been issued.

The following checklists are intended to assist you in obtaining a Building Permit. This list cannot include every unique situation but can be used for most typical projects. Supplying the most accurate and complete information on this list will prevent delays in issuing a permit and possibly reduce construction correction costs.
