T-BALL - AGES 5 & 6 / MACHINE PITCH - AGES 7 & 8

**PLACEMENT:** Whenever possible, teams are formed by geographical location.

**SEASON:** Players will be contacted by April 5th. Games will begin in late April and continue through June.

The format for T-Ball is participants hit off a tee for the first half of the season. Later in the season participants have the option of hitting coach pitch. The format for Machine Pitch is 5

innings, ten players on the field and everyone is in the batting lineup.

**PLAY DATES:** Monday - Friday at 5:30 or 7:00 p.m. & Saturday mornings and early afternoons.

**PRACTICE:** Will start by mid-April and are up to our volunteer coaches.

**EQUIPMENT:** Each child will need a glove and athletic shoes. The Recreation Department will provide a T-shirt and

a cap that the player will keep after the season.

MAJOR II LEAGUE / AGES 9 & 10

**PLACEMENT:** Participants in this league must complete placement drills before being placed on a team.

The Placement Drill schedule is below.

ALL players will be required to go through the draft for the 2013 Season. Please note try-out times

and locations below and make arrangements to be at your try-out.

PLAYER MUST PLAY IN SCHOOL DISTRICT THEY RESIDE IN!!!

**SEASON:** Games will begin in mid-April and will run through mid-June. Games are six innings long and players

will pitch. This is an instructional league.

**PLAY DATES:** Monday - Friday, 5:30 or 7:00 p.m., Saturday mornings & early afternoons.

**PRACTICE:** Major II teams will practice an average of two times each week and play twice each week. Practices will

begin a few days after placement drills.

**EQUIPMENT:** Players will be issued a jersey and cap, which is theirs to keep. All players are required to have a glove,

rubber cleats (recommended), baseball socks, and WHITE game pants. A complete uniform is required

for participation in games. All of these items can be found at local sports stores.
