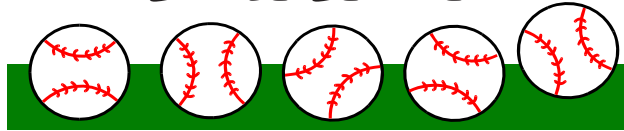

THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, MARCH 19TH AT 5:00 P.M.

Please note: A late registration period will be held March 22rd through March 26th with a \$20.00 late fee attached to the normal registration fee. The accepted late registration forms are not guaranteed to be placed on preferred area team. **NO REGISTRATION FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MARCH 26TH!! THIS DEADLINE IS ABSOLUTE.**

	T-BALL - AGES 5 & 6 / COACH PITCH - AGES 7 & 8
PLACEMENT SEASON	Whenever possible, teams are formed by geographical location. Players will be contacted by April 10th. Games will begin in late April and continue through June. The format for T-Ball is 3 inning games & everyone wins. The format for Coach Pitch is 3 innings, ten players on the field and everyone is in the batting lineup. The coach pitches to each batter.
PLAY DATES	Monday - Friday at 5:30 or 7:00 p.m. & Saturday mornings.
PRACTICE	Will start by mid-April and are up to our volunteer coaches.
EQUIPMENT	Each child will need a glove and athletic shoes. The Recreation Department will provide a T-shirt and a cap that the player will keep after the season.

	MAJOR II - LEAGUE / AGES 9 & 10
PLACEMENT SEASON	Participants in this league must complete placement drills before being placed on a team. The Placement Drill schedule is below. ALL players will be required to go through the draft for the 2010 Season. Please note try-out times and locations below and make arrangements to be at your try-out. <u>PLAYER MUST PLAY IN SCHOOL DISTRICT THEY RESIDE IN!!!</u>
PLAY DATES	Games will begin in mid-April and will run through mid-June. Games are six innings long and players will pitch. Instructional league.
PRACTICE	Monday - Friday, 5:30 or 7:00 p.m., Saturday mornings & early afternoons.
EQUIPMENT	Major II teams will practice an average of two times each week and play twice each week. Practices will begin a few days after placement drills. Players will be issued a jersey and cap, which is theirs to keep. All players are required to have a glove, rubber cleats (suggested), baseball socks, and WHITE game pants. A complete uniform is required for participation in games. All of these items can be found at local sports stores.
